The Need

Haiti is at the bottom of the world when it comes to health care. There are 25 physicians and 11 nurses per 100,000 people and only one-fourth of births are attended by a skilled health professional. Haiti suffers from poor sanitation, poor nutrition and inadequate health services. HIV/AIDS causes one-fifth of all infant deaths and has orphaned 200,000+ children. In Haiti, life expectancy is 54 years.



Our Mission

Our mission is to build a fully functional and modern 100 bed hospital called Mercy Hospital which will be capable of providing both in-patient and out-patient services to the population of Les Cayes, Haiti with the ultimate goal of elevating the state of healthcare in the region.
